



NAAEI and State and Local Apartment Association Partnerships with Colleges and Universities

NAAEI is working with the following colleges and universities in partnership with our state and local apartment associations. Our relationships with universities have included:

- *providing NALP, CAM and CAPS curricula*
- *bringing in industry leaders to convince university administrators that property management is a growing industry that offers exciting opportunities for college graduates*
- *offering free NALP, CAM and CAPS courses to university faculty (those without background in property management)*
- *offering college students the opportunity to earn NALP and CAM designations at cost*
- *offering free registrations to the NAA Education Conference for up to 4 students/faculty per university*
- *hosting an event for Summer Interns in Washington, DC to help them become more familiar with NAA*
- *offering financial support for university research and adjunct faculty*
- *serving on university advisory boards*

NAAEI also works with community and technical colleges to offer the Certificate for Apartment Maintenance Technicians and National Apartment Leasing Professional designations as part of college workforce development/continuing education. NAAEI works with existing community college faculty to deliver the programs and in some cases identifies an industry professional to instruct. NAAEI reaches out to members of the local apartment associations to invite them to serve as advisors before the programs begin, to be guest lecturers and to participate in career fairs upon completion of the programs. In Texas, the Texas Apartment Association Education Foundation does the day to day management of programs. NAAEI also offers community college administrators and faculty considering offering CAMT and NALP the opportunity to attend our June Education Conference. This gets them acclimated to the industry and allows them to meet their local property management professionals. Attendance at our conference typically jump starts community college CAMT and NALP programs. NAAEI also partners with Goodwill Industries and JVS (Jewish Vocational Services) and local community colleges to offer CAMT training to Goodwill and JVS clients. Goodwill and JVS provide the wraparound support services necessary for hiring success.
